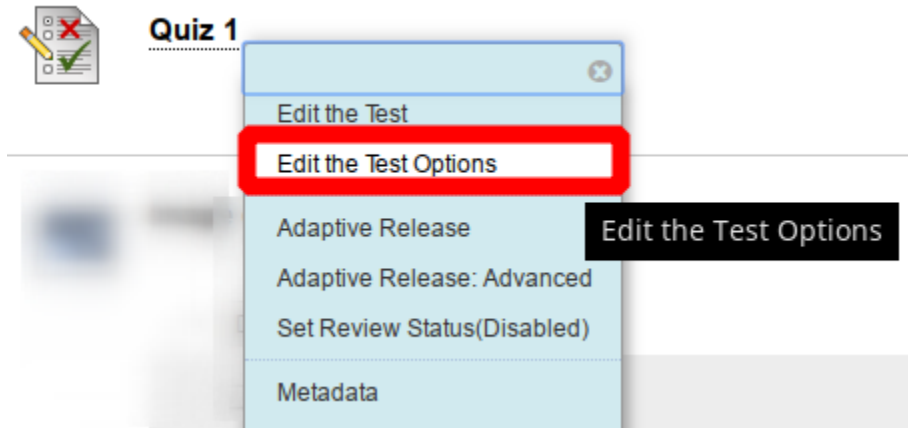


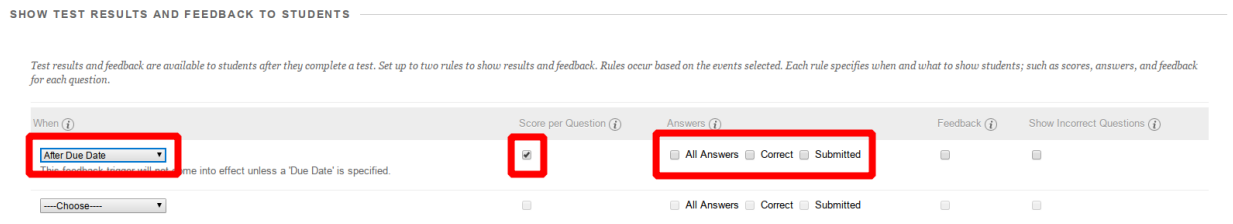


Show Feedback for Blackboard Tests and Quizzes

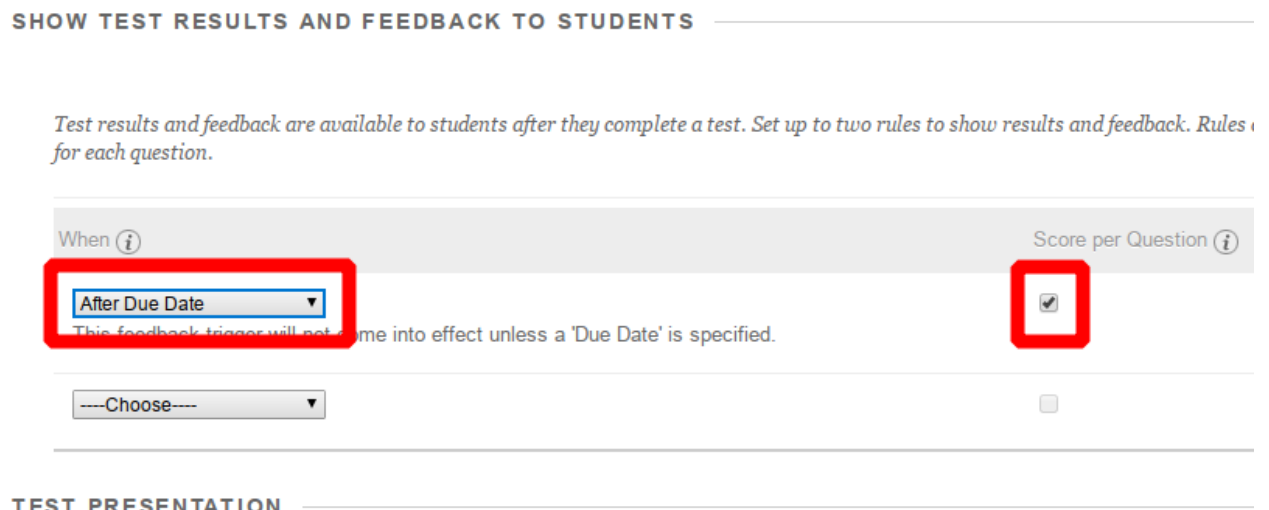
1. Log into Blackboard and select your course. Then navigate to your quiz. Then click the chevron and click **Edit Test Options**.



2. Scroll down to **Show Test Results and Feedback** and select the options you want

- I usually choose after due date and submitted answers. However, you can choose what best fits your needs here are the descriptions:
 - Score Per Question** = Will just show the question and the point value (if available and doesn't need manual grading)
 - All Answers** = Showing All Answers available in the question
 - Correct** = Show what the correct answer is (in conjunction with all it will put a check mark beside the correct one, on its own it will just show the correct with a checkmark)
 - Submitted** = Will show the answer submitted by the student.
- Select **Feedback** if you want them to see feedback you have written to the students on individual test questions.
- Click **Submit**
